11	PART I. CONTINUED STATUS AS A COOPERATIVE INNOVATIVE HIGH SCHOOL				
12	AND SUBSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION PARTNER				
13	<b>SECTION 1.(a)</b> For the purposes of this section, the Wake Young Men's Leadership				
14	Academy and the Wake Young Women's Leadership Academy are referred to collectively as				
15	Academies and are referred to individually as Academy.				
16	<b>SECTION 1.(b)</b> Notwithstanding the requirements of Part 9 of Article 16 of Chapter				
17	115C of the General Statutes for an institution of higher education partner and the written				
18	agreements entered into as provided in G.S. 115C-238.53(b) (written agreement), the following				
19	shall apply to the Academies for the 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 school years:				
20	(1) The Academies shall continue to be recognized as cooperative innovative high				
21	schools.

23	G.S. 115C-238.51A(c).
