13		per mile which is the business standard mileage rate set by the Internal

16	(2)	A travel allowance at the rate which is the business standard mileage rate set			
17		by the Internal Revenue Service in Rev. Proc. 93-51, December 27, 1993,			
18		IR-2022-234, December 29, 2022, whenever the member travels, whether in			
19		or out of session, as a representative of the General Assembly or of its			
20		committees or commissions, with the approval of the Legislative Services			
21		Commission.			
22	(3)	A subsistence allowance for meals and lodging at a daily rate equal to the			
23		maximum per diem rate for federal employees traveling to Raleigh, North			
24		Carolina, as set out at 58 Federal Register 67959 (December 22, 1993), 88			
25		Federal Register 56629 (August 18, 2023), while the General Assembly is in			
26		session and, except as otherwise provided in this subdivision, while the			
27		General Assembly is not in session when, with the approval of the Speaker of			
28		the House of Representatives in the case of Representatives or the President			
29		Pro Tempore of the Senate in case of Senators, the member is:			
30		a. Traveling as a representative of the General Assembly or of its
