2	AN ACT ADOPTING THE BOTTLENOSE DOLPHIN AS THE STATE MARINE		
3	MAMMAL.		
4	Whereas, bottlenose dolphins are marine mammals that are abundant along North		
5	Carolina's coastline; and		
6	Whereas, bottlenose dolphins have a short, thick beak and a curved mouth, giving the		
7			
8	Whereas, bottlenose dolphins are usually gray in color and can range in length from		
9	6 to 13 feet long; and		
10	Whereas, bottlenose dolphins are social animals that travel in groups of 10-15, called		
11	11 "pods"; and		
12	Whereas, bottlenose dolphins produce high-pitched clicks, called "echolocation," to		
13	help them navigate and find food; and		
14	Whereas, bottlenose dolphins can swim speeds of over 20 miles per hour, dive as deep		
15	as 800 feet below the surface, and can launch themselves up to 15 feet out of the water; and		
16	Whereas, the State of North Carolina does not have an official State marine mammal;		
17	Now, therefore,		
18	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
19	SECTION 1. Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new		
20	section to read:		
21	" <u>§ 145-52. State marine mammal.</u>		
22	The bottlenose dolphin is adopted as the official marine mammal of the State of North		
23	Carolina."		
24	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
