7	dollars (\$3,175,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2023-2024 fiscal year to allocate to the East					
8	Market Street Development Corporation, a nonprofit organization, to be used for projects that					
9	stimulate economic growth and small business development and education in East Greensboro
