SECTION 1. G.S. 42-14.1 reads as rewritten:		
" § 42-14.1. Rent control.		
No county or city as defined by G.S. 160A-1 may enact, maintain, or enforce any ordinance		
or resolution which regulates the amount of rent to be charged for privately owned, single family		
or multiple unit residential or commercial rental property. This section shall not be construed as		
prohibiting any county or city, or any authority created by a county or city for that purpose, from:
