5	SECTION 1. G.S. 42-14.1 reads as rewritten:	
6	" § 42-14.1. Rent control.	
7	No county or city as defined by G.S. 160A-1 may enact, maintain, or enforce any ordinance	
8	or resolution which regulates the amount of rent to be charged for privately owned, single-family	
9	or multiple unit residential or commercial rental property. This section shall not be construed as	
10	prohibiting any county or city, or any authority created by a county or city for that purpose, from:	
11	(1) Regulating in any way property belonging to that city, county, or authority;
12	(2) Entering into agreements with private persons which regulate the amount of
13		rent charged for subsidized rental properties; or
14	(3) Enacting ordinances or resolutions restricting rent for properties assisted with
15		Community Development Block Grant Funds."
