A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE MAYOR FOR THE TOWN OF SILER CITY
FROM TWO YEARS TO A FOUR-YEAR TERM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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SECTION 1. Section 4 of the Charter of the Town of Siler City, being Chapter 88 of the Private Laws of 1887, as amended by Section 1 of Chapter 860 of the 1963 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

- "Sec. 4. The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Siler City shall be elected on Tuesday after the first Monday in May in the odd-numbered years in accordance with the following:
- (a) At the regular municipal election to be held in May, 1965, the two candidates for Commissioner receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected to serve for a term of four (4) years and the other three candidates elected as Commissioner shall serve for a term of two (2) years. Thereafter, Commissioners shall be elected to serve for four-year terms.
- (b) On Tuesday after the first Monday in May, 1965, and biennially thereafter, Beginning at the regular municipal election in 2023 and quadrennially thereafter, the Mayor shall be elected for a two-year-four-year term."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held on or after that date.
