

#### 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO MAKE BASE BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT OPERATIONS 3 OF STATE AGENCIES, DEPARTMENTS, AND INSTITUTIONS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 6 PART I. TITLE AND INTRODUCTION 7 8 TITLE OF ACT 9 SECTION 1.1. This act shall be known as the "Current Operations Appropriations 10 Act of 2023." 11 12 **INTRODUCTION** 13 **SECTION 1.2.** The appropriations made in this act are for maximum amounts necessary to provide the services and accomplish the purposes described in the budget in 14 15 accordance with the State Budget Act. Savings shall be effected where the total amounts 16 appropriated are not required to perform these services and accomplish these purposes, and the 17 savings shall revert to the appropriate fund at the end of each fiscal year, except as otherwise provided by law. 18 19 20 PART II. CURRENT OPERATIONS AND EXPANSION/GENERAL FUND 21 **GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS** 22 23 SECTION 2. Appropriations from the General Fund for the budgets of the State 24 departments, institutions, and agencies, and for other purposes as enumerated, are made for each 25 fiscal year of the 2023-2025 fiscal biennium, in accordance with the provisions of this act. 26 27 PART III. HIGHWAY FUND AND HIGHWAY TRUST FUND 28 29 **CURRENT OPERATIONS AND EXPANSION/HIGHWAY FUND** 30 SECTION 3.1. Appropriations from the State Highway Fund for the maintenance 31 and operation of the Department of Transportation and for other purposes as enumerated are made for each fiscal year of the 2023-2025 fiscal biennium, in accordance with the provisions of 32 33 this act. 34

# 18 STATE BUDGET ACT APPLIES

SECTION 5.1. The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the General
Statutes, are reenacted and shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated in this act
by reference.

## 23 MOST TEXT APPLIES ONLY TO THE 2023-2025 FISCAL BIENNIUM

SECTION 5.2. Except for statutory changes or other provisions that clearly indicate an intention to have effects beyond the 2023-2025 fiscal biennium, the textual provisions of this act apply only to funds appropriated for, and activities occurring during, the 2023-2025 fiscal biennium.

# 2829 EFFECT OF HEADINGS

30 **SECTION 5.3.** The headings to the Parts, subparts, and sections of this act are a 31 convenience to the reader and are for reference only. The headings do not expand, limit, or define 32 the text of this act, except for effective dates referring to a Part or subpart.

### 34 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

35 **SECTION 5.4.** If any section or provision of this act is declared unconstitutional or 36 invalid by the courts, it does not affect the validity of this act as a whole or any part other than 37 the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

# 3839 EFFECTIVE DATE

40 **SECTION 5.5.** Except as otherwise provided, this act becomes effective July 1, 41 2023.
