The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 1 of Chapter 126 of the General Statutes is amended by adding		
a new section to read:		
"§ 126-6.4. Inquiring about or reviewing applicant salary history is prohibited.		
	The hiring process for State government employment shall not include screening	ı <u>g job</u>
applicants based upon salary history.		
	No person participating in a State employee selection process may (i) ask an app	
for State employment about their salary history or (ii) seek the salary history of an applicant from		
any current or former employer or from any other person or source.		
	A prospective State employee may be asked to consent to confirmation of their s	<u>salary</u>
history after an offer of employment with compensation has been made.		
	For the purposes of this section, the term "salary history" includes wages, ber	
and any other forms of compensation connected to an applicant's current or previous		
employment."		

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
