|    | (b) Waters that have been classified as trout waters by the Environmental Management          |
|    | ommission shall have an undisturbed, vegetated buffer zone 25 feet wide where activities      |
|    | cluded under subdivision (a)(1) of this section are prohibited. The Commission, however, may  |
|    | prove plans that include land-disturbing activity within the 25-foot buffer when the duration |
|    | the disturbance would be temporary and the extent of the disturbance would be minimal in the  |
| di | scretion of the Commission. The Commission may take any action reasonably necessary to        |

33 <u>enforce this requirement.</u>"

34 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2024, and applies to tracts or 35 portions of tracts on which activities set forth under G.S. 113A-52.01(a)(1), as amended by this 36 act, are initiated on or after that date.
