A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE TOTAL APPRAISED VALUE OF ALL REAL ESTATE PRIZES OFFERED DURING A CALENDAR YEAR BY A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION AS PART OF A RAFFLE.

13 14 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-309.15(g) reads as rewritten:

"(g) Real property may be offered as a prize in a raffle. The maximum appraised value of real property that may be offered for any one raffle is <u>five-seven</u> hundred <u>fifty</u> thousand dollars (\$500,000). (\$750,000). The total appraised value of all real estate prizes offered by any nonprofit organization shall not exceed <u>five-seven</u> hundred <u>fifty</u> thousand dollars (\$500,000) (\$750,000) in any calendar year. No more than three real estate prizes may be offered by any nonprofit <u>organization in any calendar year.</u>"

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to raffles conducted on or after that date.
