The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1.(a) Section 9C.4(b) of S.L. 2021-180 reads as rewritten:		
"SECTION 9C.4.(b) Fees for families who are required to share in the cost of care are		
established based on ten percent (10%) five percent (5%) of gross family income. When care is		
received at the blended rate, the copayment shall be eighty-three percent (83%) of the full-time		
copayment. (Copayments for part-time care shall be seventy-five percent (75%) of	f the full-time
copayment."		
\mathbf{S}	ECTION 1.(b) It is the intent of the General Assembly to use a p	portion of the
anticipated increase in funds to the Child Care and Development Fund Block Grant to supplement		
funding for the copayment decrease described in subsection (a) of this section.		
S	ECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2023.
