2	AN ACT TO EXPEDITE TRANSFER OF WATER OR WASTEWATER PUBLIC UTILITIES.
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	SECTION 1. G.S. 62-111 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
5	"(f) Within 30 days of the filing of an application for the transfer of a water or wastewater
6	franchise under this section, or for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to acquire
7	control or operate a water or wastewater system pursuant to G.S. 62-110, the Commission shall
8	(i) determine whether or not the application is complete and notify the applicant accordingly and
9	(ii) if the Commission determines an application is incomplete, specify all such deficiencies in
10	the notice to the applicant. The applicant may file an amended application or supplemental
11	information to cure the deficiencies identified by the Commission for the Commission's review.
12	If the Commission fails to issue a notice as to whether or not the application is complete within
13	the requisite 30-day period, the application shall be deemed complete. Within 180 days of the
14	filing of a completed application, the Commission shall issue an order approving the application
15	upon finding that the proposed transfer, including adoption of the transferring utility's currently
16	approved rates, or the requested certificate of convenience and necessity, as applicable, is in the
17	public interest, will not adversely affect service to the public under any existing franchise, and
18	the person acquiring said franchise or certificate of public convenience and necessity has the
19	technical, managerial, and financial capabilities necessary to provide public utility service to the
20	public. The requirements of this subsection shall only apply to water or wastewater systems with
21	an unresolved notice of violation issued by the Department of Environmental Quality."
22	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to applications
23	for transfer or certificates of public convenience and necessity pending or filed on or after that
24	date.



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
