Short Title: Universal AIG Screening in Middle Schools. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP OR  
3 PURCHASE AND DISSEMINATE A SCREENING ASSESSMENT FOR  
4 ACADEMICALLY OR INTELLECTUALLY GIFTED CHILDREN TO BE  
5 ADMINISTERED IN SIXTH GRADE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-150.6 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

8 "(1a) (i) Develop or purchase and (ii) disseminate a screening assessment to be used  
9 in all middle schools to identify academically or intellectually gifted  
10 students."

11 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 115C-150.7(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

12 "(1a) The use of the screening assessment provided pursuant to  
13 G.S. 115C-150.6(1a) for all students in grade six to assist in identifying  
14 academically or intellectually gifted students."

15 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
16 Public Instruction the sum of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) in recurring funds for the  
17 2025-2026 fiscal year to cover the costs of the screening assessments provided pursuant to this  
18 act.

19 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2025.
