A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP OR PURCHASE AND DISSEMINATE A SCREENING ASSESSMENT FOR ACADEMICALLY OR INTELLECTUALLY GIFTED CHILDREN TO BE ADMINISTERED IN SIXTH GRADE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-150.6 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(1a) (i) Develop or purchase and (ii) disseminate a screening assessment to be used in all middle schools to identify academically or intellectually gifted students."

**SECTION 2.** G.S. 115C-150.7(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(1a) The use of the screening assessment provided pursuant to G.S. 115C-150.6(1a) for all students in grade six to assist in identifying academically or intellectually gifted students."

**SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) in recurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to cover the costs of the screening assessments provided pursuant to this act.

**SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2025.
