1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO ENACT THE MOTORCYCLE ROAD GUARD SAFETY ACT.  
3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-114.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 "(e) A person holding a motorcycle road guard certificate issued under G.S. 20-114.2 may  
6 direct traffic while escorting a motorcycle group if the person meets the safety and equipment  
7 standards for operating under the certificate; has notified each city through which the motorcycle  
8 group is proceeding; and has obtained consent from the chief of police of that city."

9 **SECTION 2.** Article 3 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding  
10 a new section to read:

11 "**§ 20-114.2. Motorcycle road guard certificate.**

12 (a) No person may direct traffic as a motorcycle road guard under G.S. 20-114.1(e)  
13 without a valid motorcycle road guard certificate issued in accordance with this section.

14 (b) A person who is at least 18 years of age and has a valid drivers license may obtain a  
15 motorcycle road guard certificate upon successful completion of a motorcycle road guard  
16 certification course developed by the Division and by meeting any other requirements of the  
17 Division.

18 (c) In the course of directing traffic, a motorcycle road guard shall comply with all safety  
19 and equipment standards required by the Division."

20 **SECTION 3.** The Division of Motor Vehicles shall adopt rules to carry out the  
21 provisions of this act.

22 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2025.
