OVERVIEW: *Senate Bill 836 increases the amount of funds from the Coronavirus Relief Fund used for the continuity of operation needs across State government.*

BILL ANALYSIS: The Proposed House Committee Substitute for SB836 increases the amount of funds appropriated from the Coronavirus Relief Fund for the continuity of State government in Section 3.3(3) of S.L. 2020-4 by \$300,000,000 to \$370,000,000. Further, Section 4 directs the Office of State Budget and Management to work with relevant State agencies to identify expenditures that may be offset with these funds and do so where possible.

EFFECTIVE DATE: S836 is effective when it becomes law.
