OVERVIEW: APPROPRIATES FUNDS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA BUILDING RESERVE FOR CERTAIN BUILDING PROJECTS.

[As introduced, this bill was identical to S130, as introduced by Sens. Krawiec, Edwards, Lowe, which is currently in Senate Appropriations/Base Budget.]

Section 1 of the bill appropriates \$2,359,159 in nonrecurring funds for the current 2020-2021 fiscal year from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina for the Building Reserve. These funds are to be allocated for the operation and maintenance of building projects as follows:

- Elizabeth City State University/Moore Hall \$109,129
- UNC at Charlotte/Sciences Building \$982,090
- UNC School of the Arts/Performance Place Renovation \$42,901
- Western Carolina University/STEM Building \$1,225,039

Sections 2 and 3 contain technical boilerplate language to effectuate the appropriation and allocations.

Section 4 makes the bill effective when it becomes law.
