- "(9) \$1,000,000, in response to COVID-19, to contract with a third-party entity to conduct a statewide assessment of the cybersecurity capabilities of public schools and threats posed to public schools. In selecting a third-party entity to conduct the assessment, the Department shall not consider any entity currently under contract with the Department to provide services related to cybersecurity. The assessment required under this subdivision is confidential and not a public record as defined in G.S. 132-1. No later than June 20, 2021, the Department shall report the results of the assessment conducted by the third-party entity to the chairs of the Senate Appropriations/Base Budget Committee, the chairs of the House Appropriations Committee, the chairs of the Senate Appropriations Committee on General Government and Information Technology, and the chairs of the House Appropriations Committee on Information Technology. The report submitted by the Department is confidential and not a public record as defined in G.S. 132-1.
- (10) 9,000,000, in response to COVID-19, to contract with a third-party entity to implement a statewide cybersecurity program to improve the cybersecurity infrastructure of the public schools. The third party entity shall be a business entity with broad experience in cybersecurity services, including a history of successful contracts in this State and at least one other state, and shall not have its principal office located in the People's Republic of China or the Russian Federation. Nothing in this subdivision is intended to contravene any existing treaty, law, agreement, or regulation of the United States. The funds shall not be allocated to a public school unit, and the program shall include at least the following components:
- a. Funding for all costs related to the following for implementation of the program, as needed: hardware, software, licenses, support, maintenance, training, and labor.
- b. Preparation for and understanding of evolving technology and evolving security threats in the State.
