OVERVIEW: APPROPRIATES FUNDS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA BUILDING RESERVE FOR CERTAIN BUILDING PROJECTS.

[As introduced, this bill was identical to S130, as introduced by Sens. Krawiec, Edwards, Lowe, which is currently in Senate Appropriations/Base Budget.]

Section 1 of House Bill 142 appropriates \$2,359,159 from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina for the 2020-2021 fiscal year for the Building Reserve.

The funding will be allocated for the operation and maintenance of the following building projects:

- Elizabeth City State University, Moore Hall - \$109,129
- UNC at Charlotte, Sciences Building - \$982,090
- UNC School of the Arts, Performance Place Renovation - \$42,901
- Western Carolina University, STEM Building - \$1,225,039

Sections 2 and 3 of House Bill 142 contain boilerplate language relating to State Budget Act applicability and providing that the provisions of prior legislation do not affect these funds.

Section 4 makes the act effective when it becomes law.
