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Therapeutic Services

- Physical Therapy
 - Spa Therapy, Positioning/Adaptive Equipment, Splints, One-on-One
- Recreation
 - Adaptive Games (Wild), Boat Rides, Summer Concerts, Fun Fridays, Haunted Greenhouse, Winter Wonderland
- Technology
 - Use of Ipad, Eye Point Technology, Speech Output Devices
- Speech/Language Therapy - Communications
 - Verbal/Non-Verbal, Sign Language, Gestures, Symbols



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Education/Day Services

- Early Intervention Program
 - Intense therapy for residents ages birth -5
 - Speech, PT, Play, Music & Massage Therapy
- Special Education
 - Licensed as a school program
- LifeChoices Adult Day Activity Program
 - Promotes individual adaptive, social & emotional skills
 - Money Management, Health & Safety, Academics, Music, Art, Horticulture



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CREATIVE ARTS

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- Hand Bell Choir
 - Learn basic musical rhythms & patterns, basic chord construction, follow directions
- Visual Arts
 - Use of hand over hand techniques, make individual choices
 - Integrated with communication therapy
- Music Therapy
 - Use simple instruments – to improve cognitive, physical, social & emotional skills
 - Sound Beam, Drums & Percussion Instruments



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- Holy Angels Dance Troupe (30 Years)
 - Ballet, Contemporary Movement
 - Experience Team Work, Listening Skills, Fun
- Horticulture Therapy
 - Use adaptive shovels, other devices
 - Work in soil, care for plants, sensory activities

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Meet JR - We Believe in Miracles

- Arrived at Holy Angels - 3 Months Old - 1982
- Diagnosed with severe form of MS - wasn't expected to live
- Adopted by a Charlotte Family - 8 Years Old
- Returned in 2016 to visit at age 34
- Now volunteers in the Music Therapy program & in our IT department
- Graduated from college
- Writes his own music - says it is his passion



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CHALLENGES TO TRANSITION AND EMPLOYMENT FOR IIDD

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LIMITED SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS AFTER THEY GRADUATE

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SYSTEMS ARE CUMBERSOME AND DIFFICULT TO
NAVIGATE AND UNDERSTAND FOR IIDD AND
THEIR PARENTS/GUARDIAN

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Barrier - 1

- Medicaid eligibility requirements
 - Earned income jeopardizes Medicaid eligibility
 - "Non allowable" asset limit (2,000.00)

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Barrier - 2

- Transportation
 - Public transportation is limited in location
 - Public and private transportation is expensive

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Barrier - 3

- MCO
 - Service authorizations are required every 6 mos.
 - Increase in non reimbursable administrative requirements and documents submission

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Barrier - 4

- Technology is replacing menial labor which can be challenging for individuals with IDD

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Barrier - 5

- Limited opportunities for continuing education for individuals with IDD

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Opening First Business Cherubs Cafe

Purpose - to create meaningful employment opportunities for adult residents

- Downtown Belmont - very few businesses/no restaurants
- Major development of esthetics of Main Street
- Rent - affordable
- Location - heart of Main Street
- Much needed renovations
- Minimal Staff
- Initially No funding for supported employee services
- Initial resources
 - Volunteers
 - Donors
 - Grants

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Early Challenges

- Secure Funding
- Secure Qualified Staff - to serve as job coaches
- Funding - a moving target (and continues to move)
 - HRI
 - Developmental Therapy
 - CBI
 - CAP - Supported Employment
 - Innovations
 - IPRS



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Cherubs Candy Bouquet Opened 1997



- Not everyone is able to work in a café setting or wanted to work there
- Needed more variety - more of a production - with jobs for every level of ability
- Candy Bouquet Franchise - Donated
- In Candy Bouquet
 - We found a product that would sell
 - A production rate job for everyone

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Community Need for IIDD Services

- MCO identified need for vocational & employments services - long waiting list
- Holy Angels had successful history of vocational & employment services for our residents
- To address needs - Holy Angels developed LifeChoices to provide training/vocational services and employment opportunities
- Some students who recently graduated with certificate - transitioned to LifeChoices & preparing for employment.

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LifeChoices Vocational Program

- Day program that is designed to :
 - Teach pre-vocational skills such as:
 - Attendance/time management
 - Task completion, commitment, initiative
 - Interpersonal skills
 - Communication and self advocacy skills
 - Attention span
 - Workplace safety
 - Money and computer skills
 - Assess individual interests, aptitudes, and degree of support needed

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LifeChoices

- Upon entry in to LifeChoices the following areas are assessed for each individual
 - Vocational interest scale (Reading-Free Vocational Interest Inventory - Second Edition)
 - Level of support scale (Becker Work Adjustment Profile - Second Edition)
 - Reading level (Reading Level Assessment Tool - A to Z Homeschool Products)

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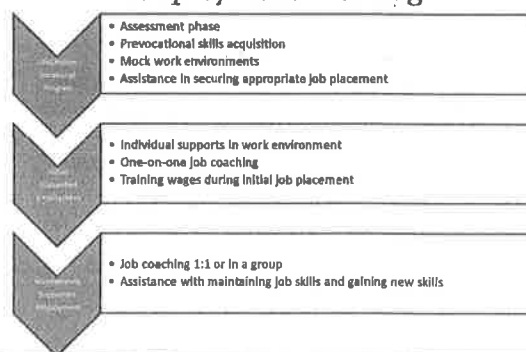
LifeChoices cont.

- Together, these assessments help the individual explore vocational options and set goals based on
 - what they would like to do
 - how much support they need to be successful
 - literacy level and increasing literacy skills.


It is well documented that literacy is a key component of vocational success, and participants have increased options for job placement based on level of literacy.

- All employees are coached according to their individual support needs


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Meaningful Work Cont.



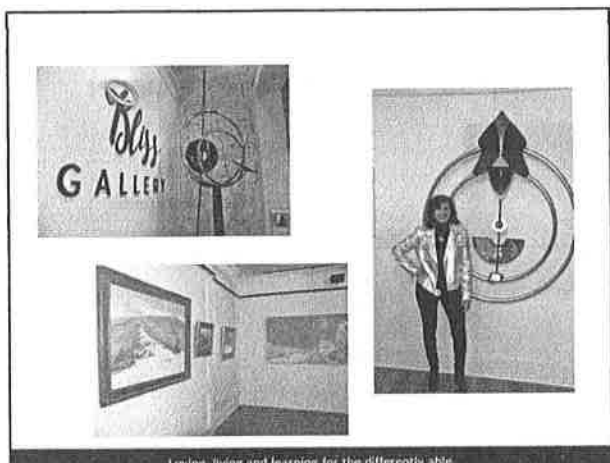

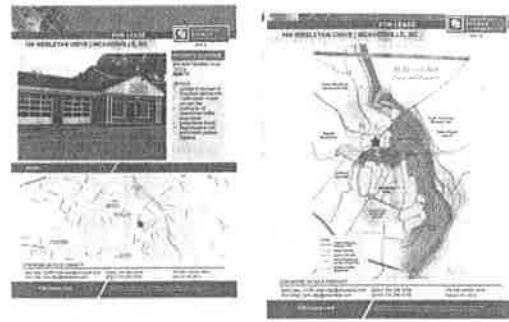
