2 " **SECTION 1.** G.S. 62A-41 reads as rewritten:

3 '(a) Membership. – The 911 Board is established in the Office of Information
4 Technology Services. A local government unit that receives a distribution from the fund under
5 G.S. 62A-46 and a telecommunication service provider may not have more than 1
6 representative on the 911 Board. The 911 Board consists of 17 members as follows:

7 (1) Four members appointed by the Governor as follows:

- 8 a. An individual who represents municipalities appointed upon the
9 recommendation of the North Carolina League of Municipalities.
10 b. An individual who represents counties appointed upon the
11 recommendation of the North Carolina Association of County
