1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 5-6, by rewriting those lines to read:

4 CODIFY CAPITAL PROJECT REPORTING REQUIREMENTS, TO PROVIDE SECURITY
5 FOR THE MORGANTON CAMPUS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA SCHOOL OF SCIENCE
6 AND MATHEMATICS, AND TO EXEMPT STUDENT DISCIPLINARY INFORMATION
7 FROM PUBLIC RECORDS.";

9 and on page 6, lines 49-50, by inserting the following between those lines:

11 **"PART IVA. PROVIDE SECURITY FOR THE MORGANTON CAMPUS OF THE**
12 **NORTH CAROLINA SCHOOL OF SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS**

13 **SECTION 4A. G.S. 122C-430 reads as rewritten:**

14 **"§ 122C-430. Joint security force.**

15 (a) The Secretary may designate one or more special police officers who shall make up
16 a joint security force to enforce the law of North Carolina and any ordinance or regulation
17 adopted pursuant to G.S. 143-116.6 or G.S. 143-116.7 or pursuant to the authority granted the
18 Department by any other law on the territory of the Broughton Hospital, Western Regional
19 Vocational Rehabilitation Facility, J. Iverson Riddle Developmental Center, the Morganton
20 campus of the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics, and the surrounding grounds
21 and land adjacent to Broughton Hospital allocated to the Department of Agriculture and
22 Consumer Services, all in Burke County. After taking the oath of office for law enforcement
23 officers as set out in G.S. 11-11, these special police officers have the same powers as peace
24 officers now vested in sheriffs within the territory embraced by the named facilities. These
25 special police officers may arrest persons outside the territory of the named institutions but within
26 the confines of Burke County when the person arrested has committed a criminal offense within
27 that territory for which the officers could have arrested the person within that territory, and the
28 arrest is made during the person's immediate and continuous flight from that territory.

29 (b) Upon assignment by the Secretary, or Secretary's designee, to any State-operated
30 facility pursuant to G.S. 122C-183, these special police officers may exercise the same power
31 enumerated in this Part within the territory of the named facility and within the county in which
32 the facility is located."

PART IVB. EXEMPT STUDENT DISCIPLINARY INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC RECORDS

SECTION 4B. G.S. 132-1.1 reads as rewritten:

"§ 132-1.1. Confidential communications by legal counsel to public board or agency; State tax information; public enterprise billing information; Address Confidentiality Program ~~information~~information, and other confidential information.

...

(f1) Student Disciplinary Information. - Any information related to a complaint, investigation, or resolution of an alleged violation of or noncompliance with the disciplinary or conduct rules or other policy of The University of North Carolina or one of its constituent institutions involving a student of a constituent institution is confidential and is not a public record as defined in G.S. 132-1.
