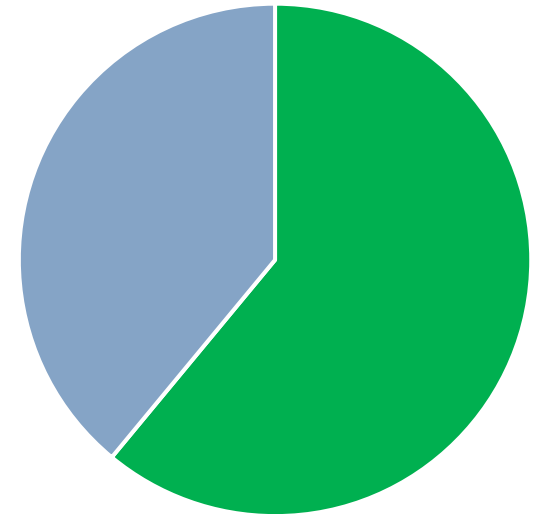

Distributed Energy Resources (DER) & Cooperative Solar

Over 500 MW of DER/Edge of Grid

Other Renewables (including residential)	27 MW
Conservation Voltage Reduction	50 MW
Customer-owned Generation	60 MW
Battery Storage	42 MW
Connected Thermostats and Water Heaters	9.5 MW



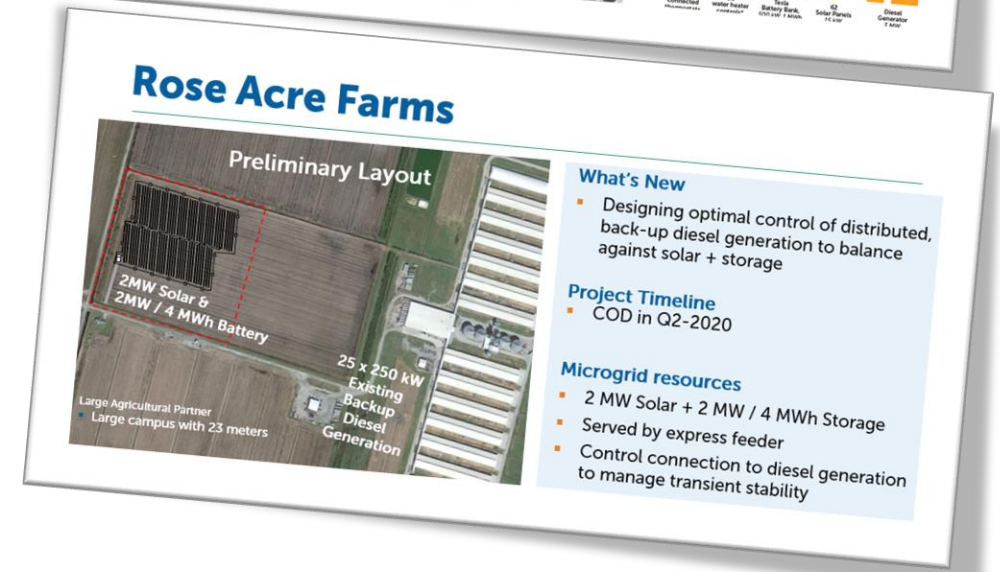
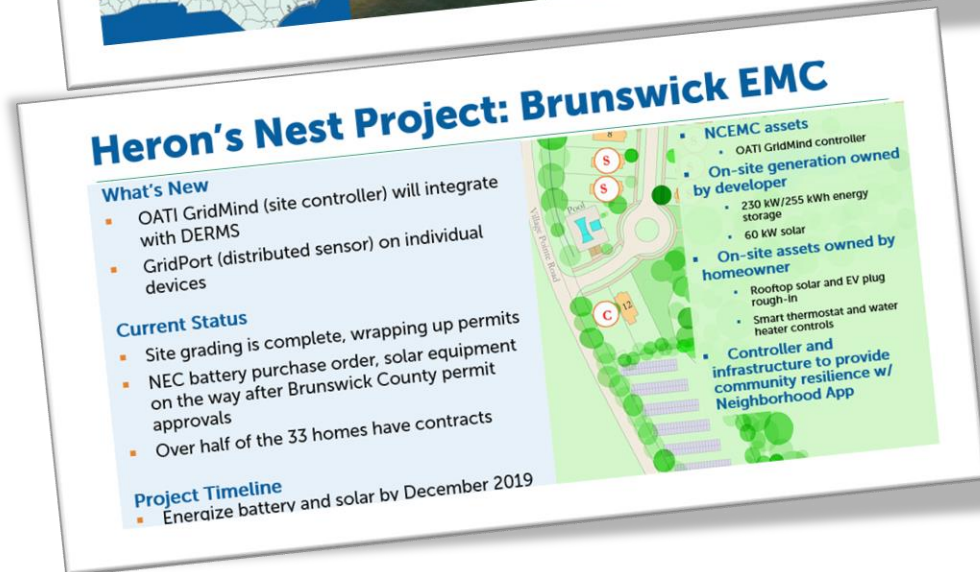
Solar + Storage

Community Solar in NC

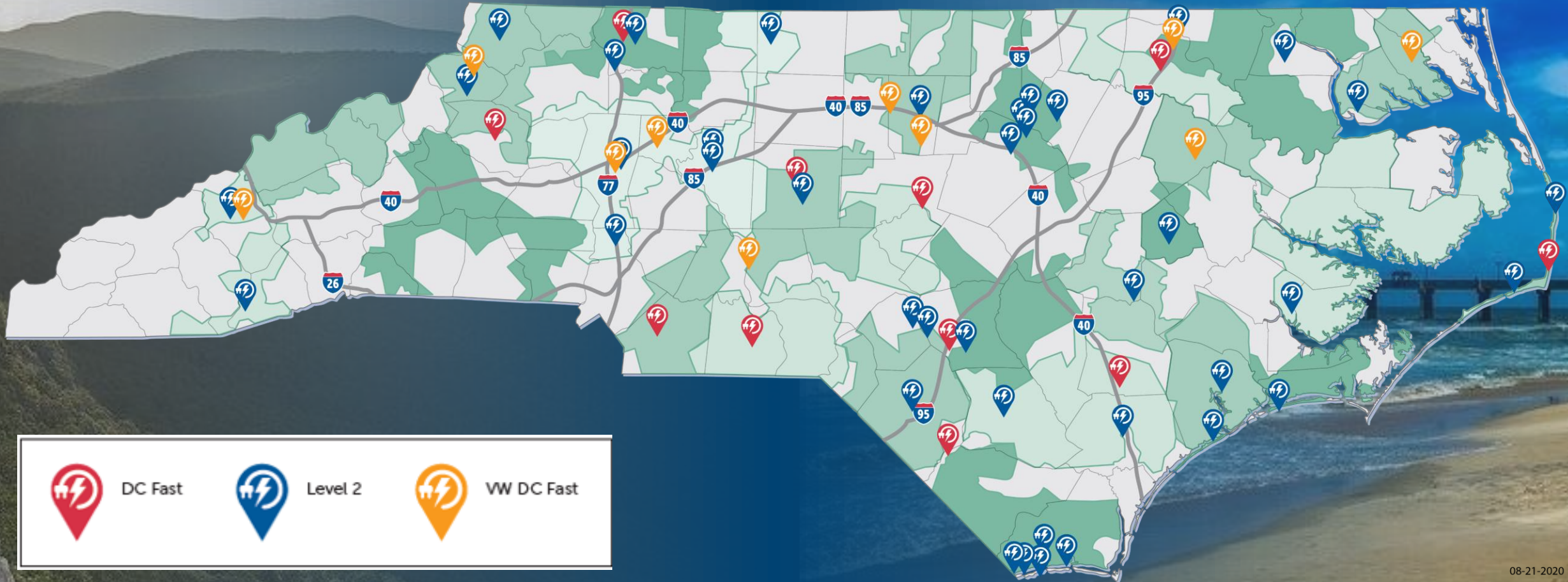


NC Co-ops' Microgrids



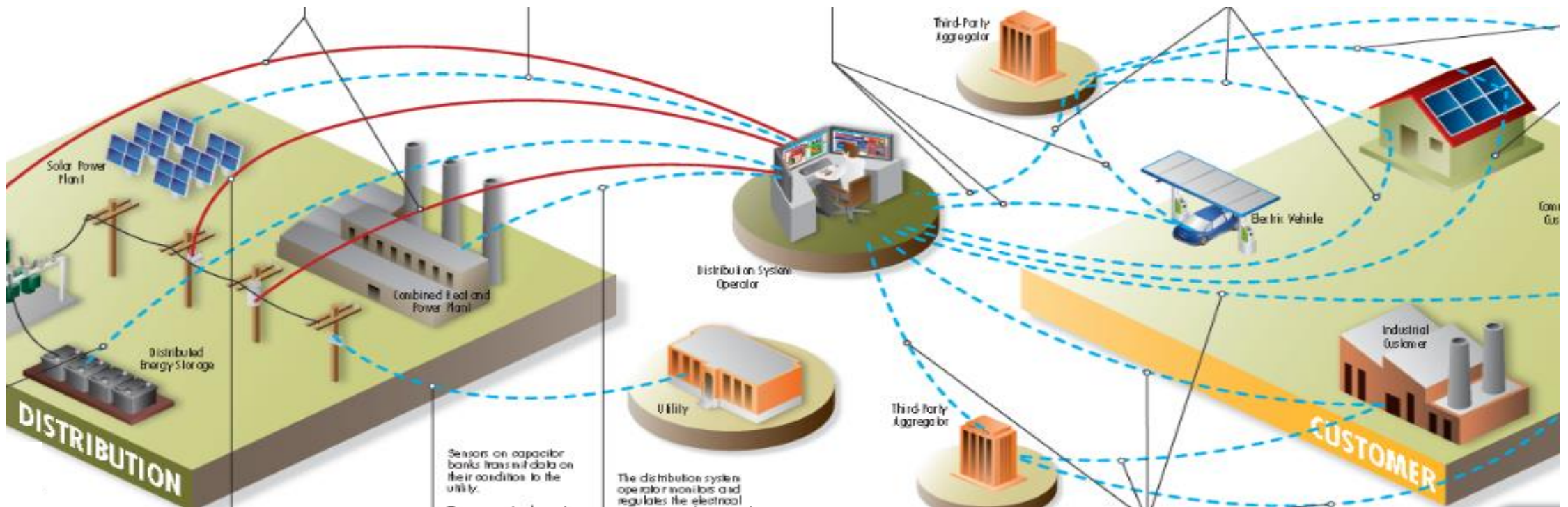
NC Electric Cooperatives EV Charging Network

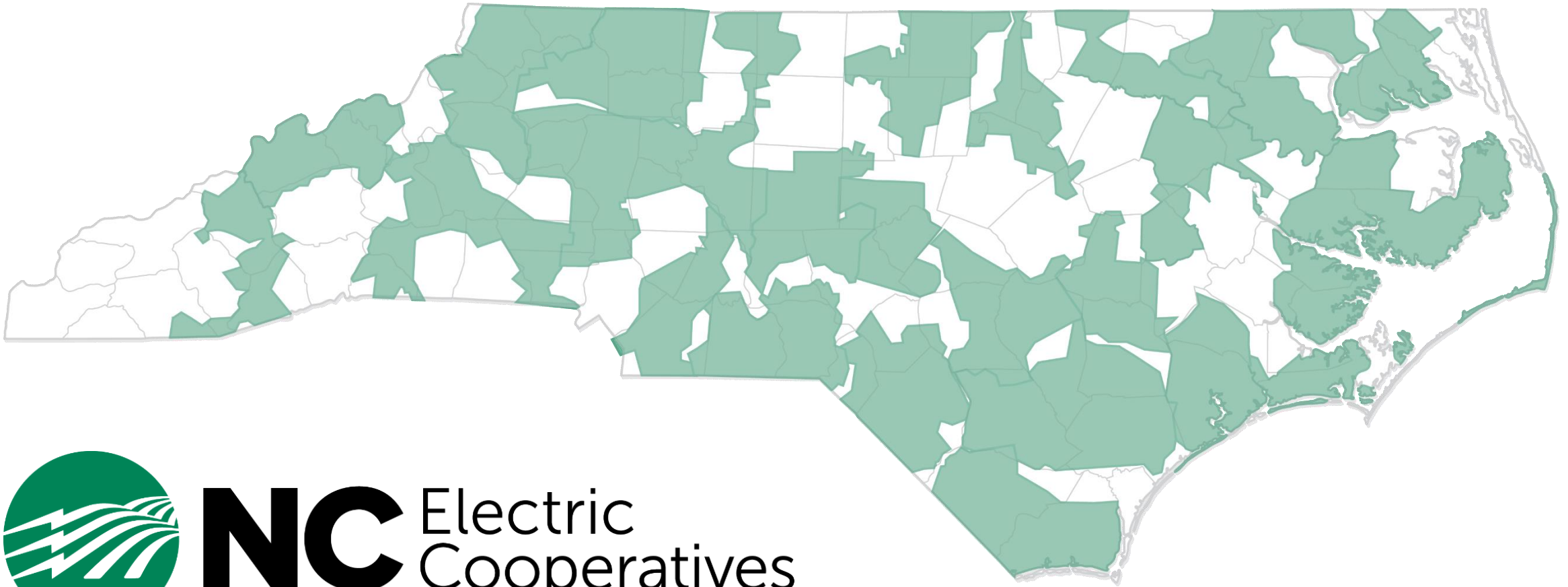
Level 2 and DC Fast Charging Stations Across NC Co-op Territories
