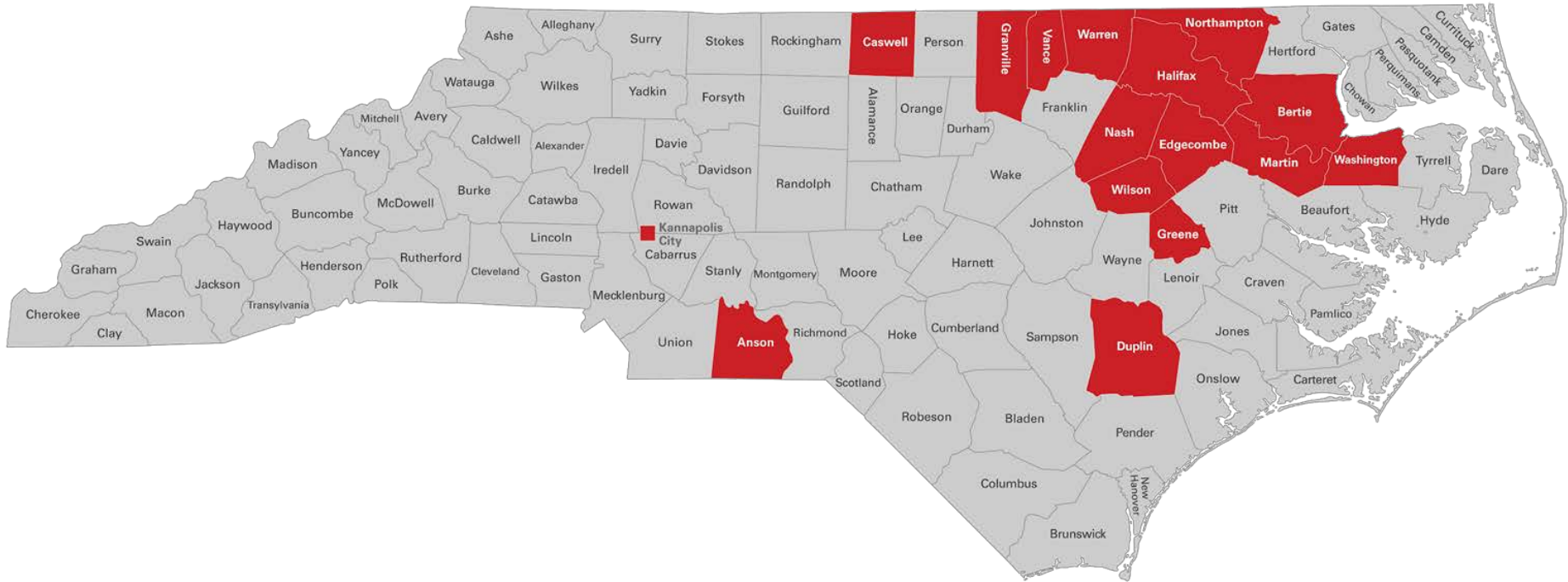
Wolfpack WORKS

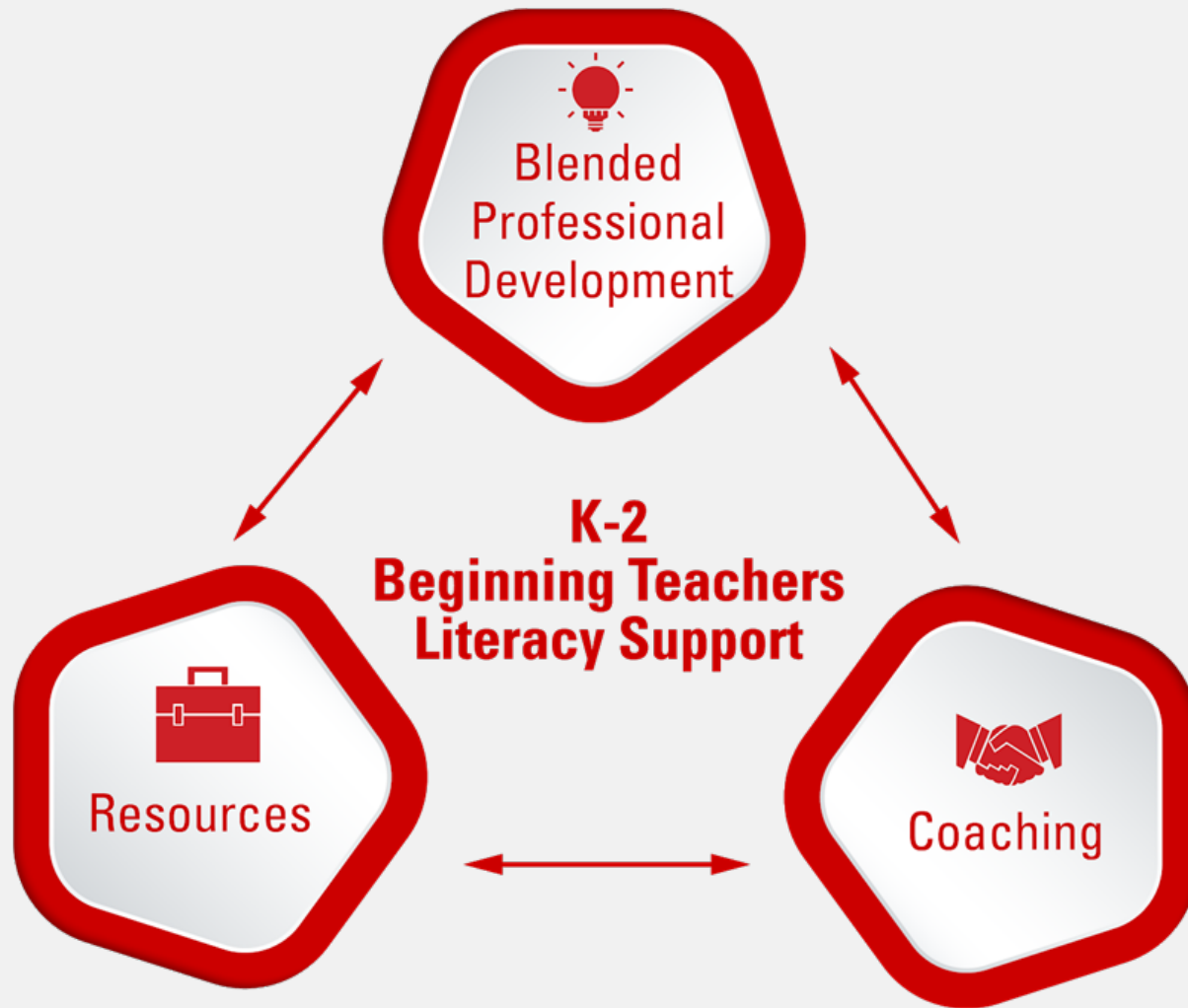

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Evaluating Impacts

During Pilot Year

- Program Engagement

- > Overall gains in self-efficacy at mid-year
- > Greater gains among teachers from alternative pathways
- > Positive feedback from principals and district leaders
- > Impacts on teaching & students
