

### Raise the Age vs. Non-Raise the Age Complaints

The Fiscal Research staff presentation on the Juvenile Justice Section presented data on the disposition of Raise the Age (RtA) Complaints vs. Non-Raise the Age (Non-RtA) Complaints for calendar year 2019. Committee members requested the same data for CY 2020. Staff has followed-up with the agency to provide the updated counts below.

### Most Common Violation for Revocation

As shown in the graphic below, the Sentencing and Policy Advisory Commission found that the most common violation leading to revocation since the passage of the Justice Reinvestment Act has been absconding.

Following the JRA, there have been far fewer revocations and the distribution by type has changed considerably
