Subject: State Capitol Police Receipt Supported Position Creation

Date: September 28, 2016

Pursuant of Section 16B.4(c). of Session Law 2015-241, Additional Reporting Required Upon Creation of Receipt-Supported Positions. – In addition to the report required by subsection (b) of this section, the State Capitol Police shall report the creation of any position pursuant to subsection (a) of this section to the chairs of the House of Representatives and Senate Appropriations Committees on Justice and Public Safety and to the Fiscal Research Division within 30 days of the position's creation. A report submitted pursuant to this section shall include at least the following information:

- (1) The position type.*
- (2) The agency to which the position is being assigned.*
- (3) The position salary.*
- (4) The total amount of the contract.*
- (5) The terms of the contract.*

State Capitol Police have two new (standard agreement) **contracts effective October 1, 2016.**

Position Type	Contract Agency	Position Salary	Totals Contract Amount	Term of Contract
Public Safety Officer	Department of Public Instruction (DPI)- New Education*	\$36,680.21	\$63,550.10	1 Year
Public Safety Officer	North Carolina Office of the State Auditor*	\$36,680.21	\$63,550.10	1 Year

NOTE: DPI signed an agreement for 12 months, but since an officer is not being assigned until October there will only be invoices and reimbursements for 9 months in the current FY. (Roughly 75% of the agreement) The Auditor's contract specified it would begin Oct. 1st so it is a 9-month contract this FY. (\$50,872.78) The renewals will be full year agreements.

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
