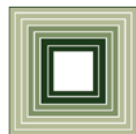

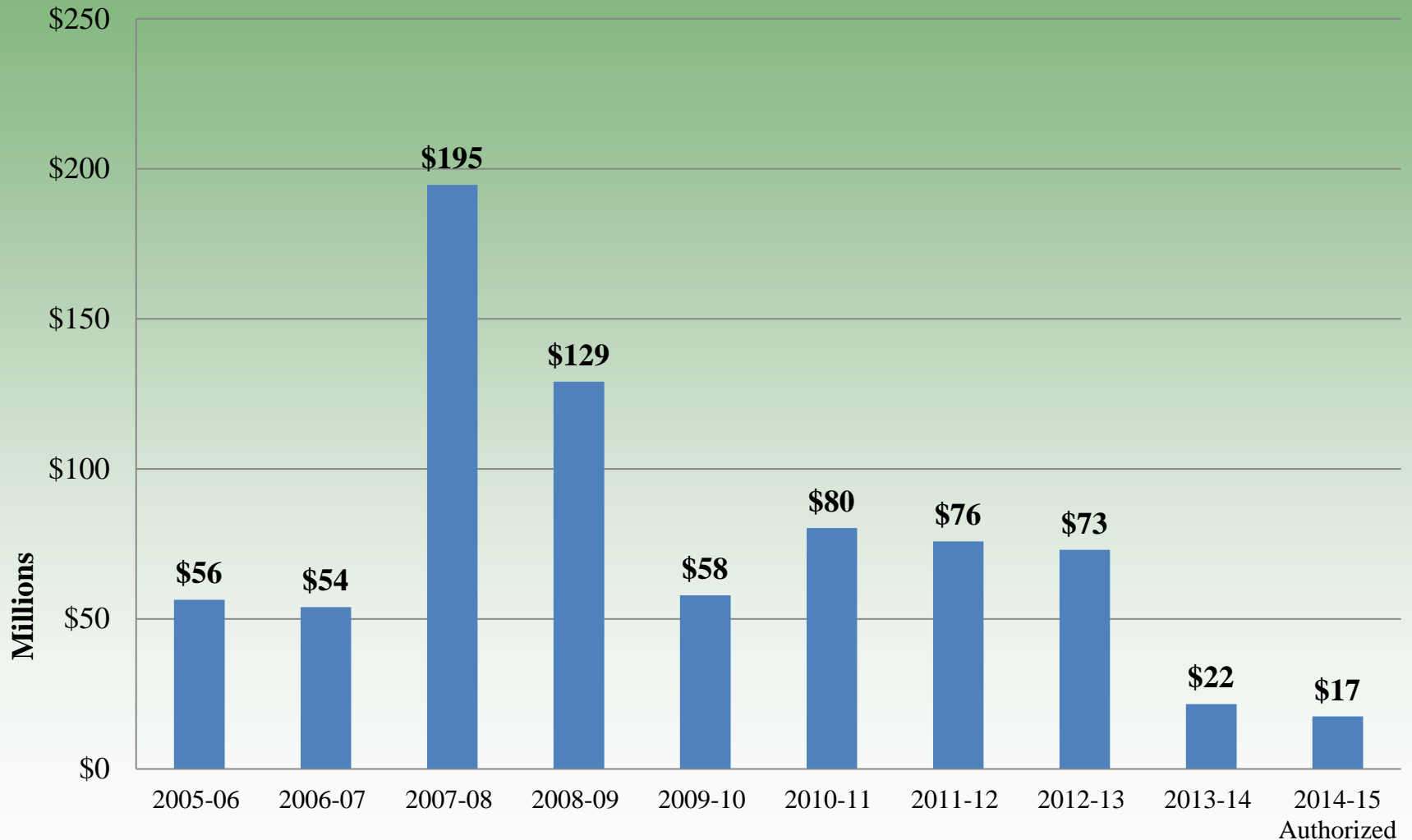

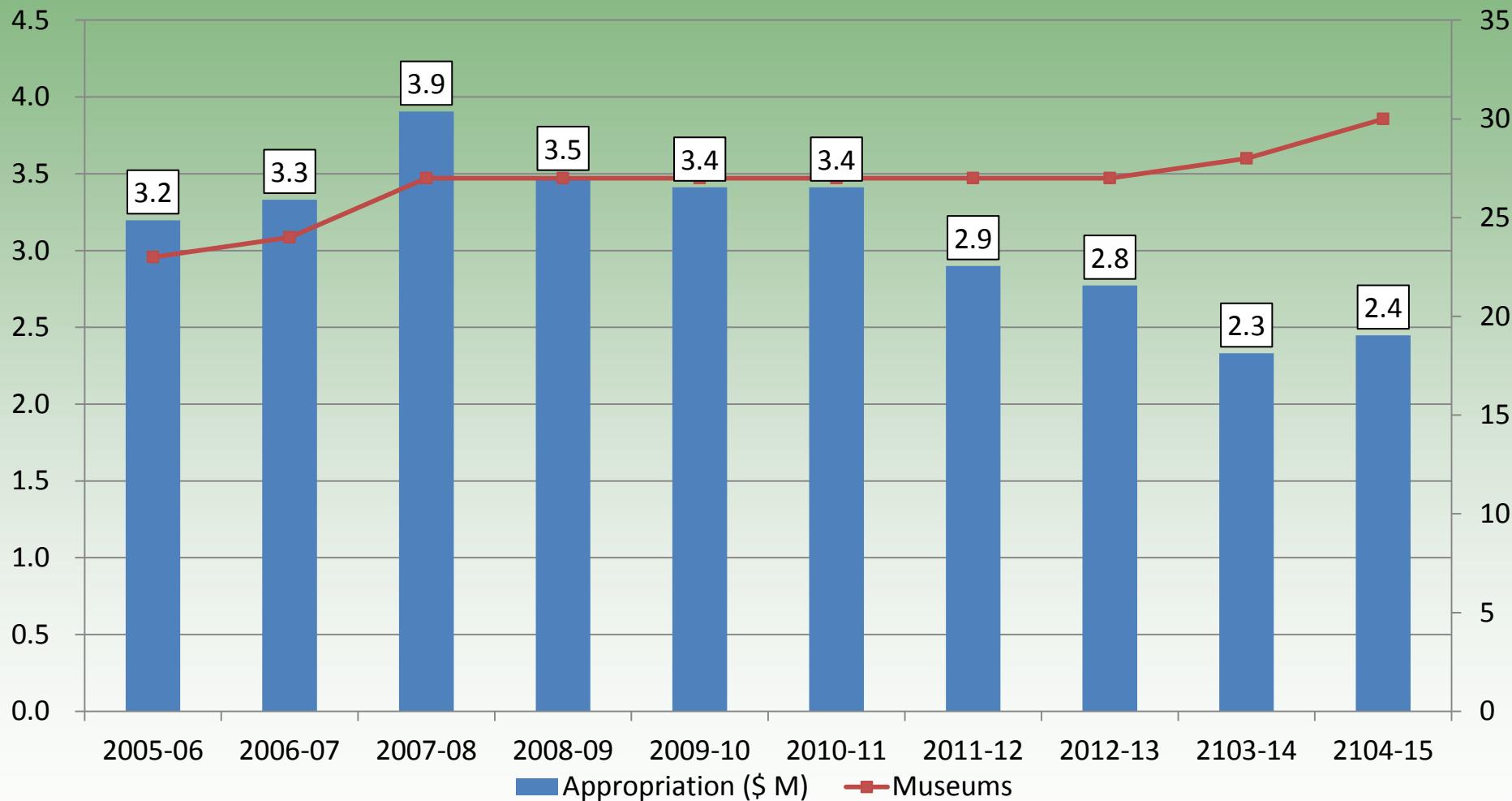


Grassroots Science Museums

- Grassroots Science Program started in 1993-94 with a \$450,000 appropriation to 10 museums
- FY 2014-15 Funding Totals \$2.4 M for 30 museums
- New museums added in FY 2014-15:
 - Cowan Museum of History & Science (Duplin)
 - Hands On! (Henderson)
 - Marbles Kids Museum (Wake)
- Museums are funded at a base rate of \$58,000; any remaining funds available after this base allocation is distributed to the museums on a pro-rata basis, as determined by their prior year actual operating budget

Funding History

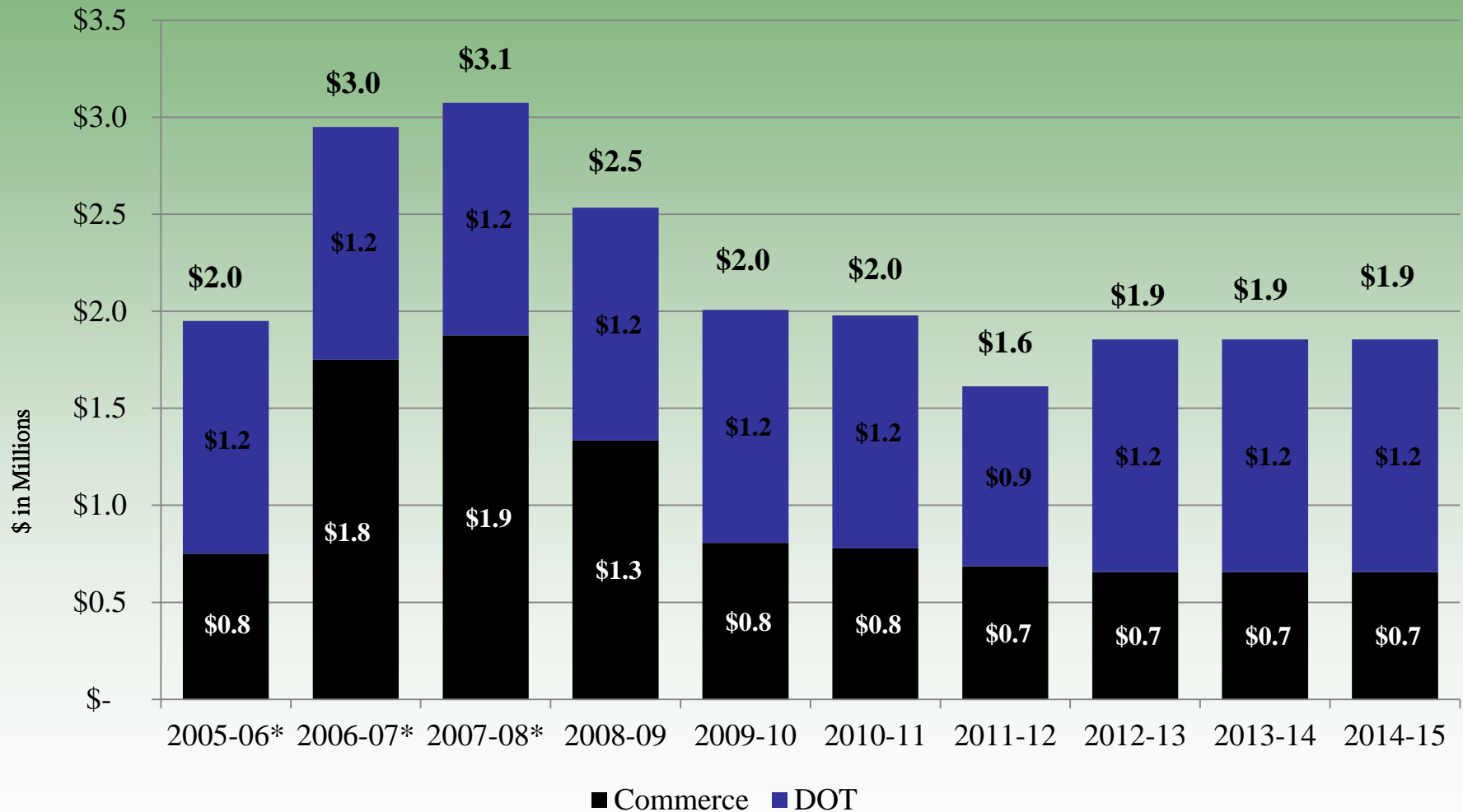


High Point Market Authority

- Official sponsor and organizer of “The Market,” which is a Trade Show for furniture makers and retailers
- Founded in 1909
- 11.5M square feet of show space in 180 buildings
- Brings approximately 160,000 visitors from over 100 countries
- Oversees transportation, registration, website, and marketing
- Appropriations began in FY 2005-06
