Department of Commerce

1. How has the Department of Commerce's Management Flexibility reduction of \$257,315 from FY 2015-16 implemented?

The Rural Economic Development Division of Commerce underwent a reorganization during the FY15-16. As a result of the reorganization, cost savings to the department were approximately \$450,000. The reorganization affected 7 positions in the Rural Economic Development Division. 2 of the eliminated positions were vacant and 5 were filled. The abolished positions are listed below:
