Receipts: \$29.2 m

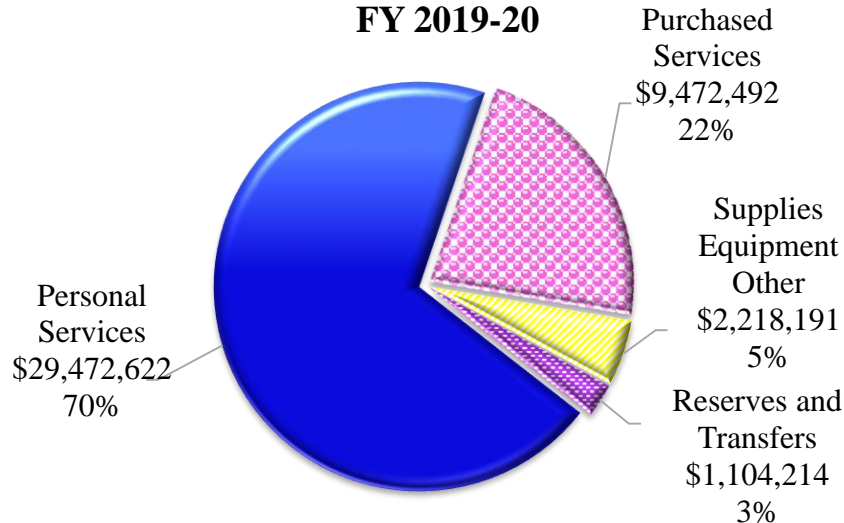
Net Approp.: \$13.1 m

FY 2019-20**



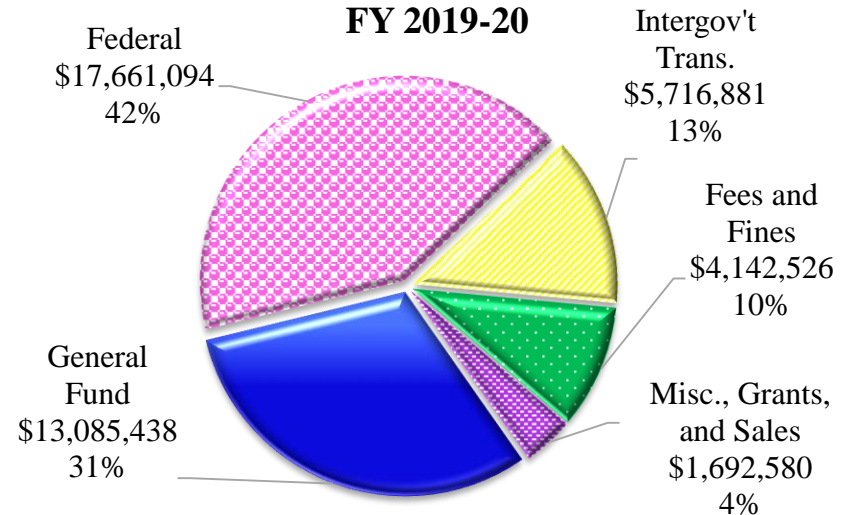

FY 2019-20**



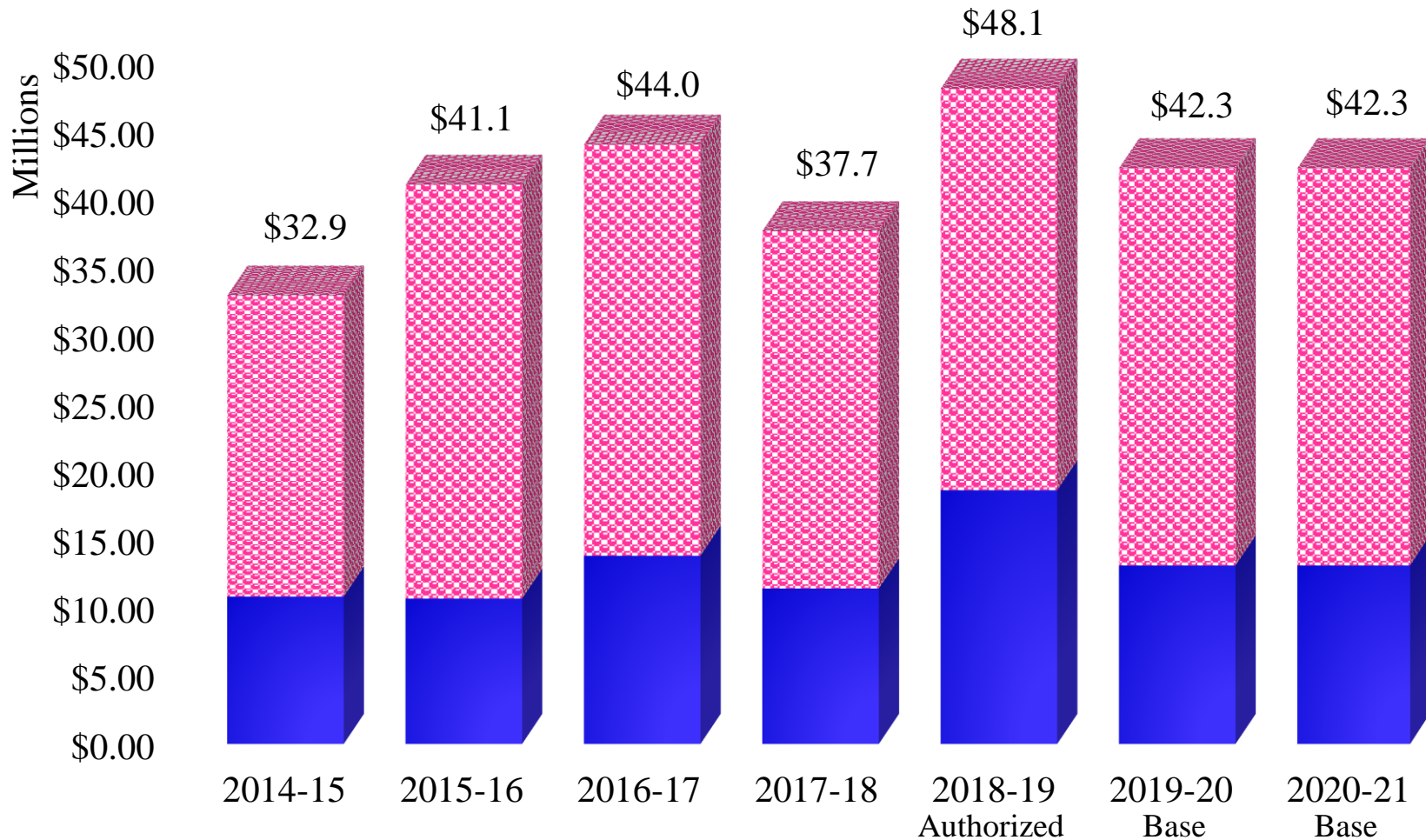

- Capacity development

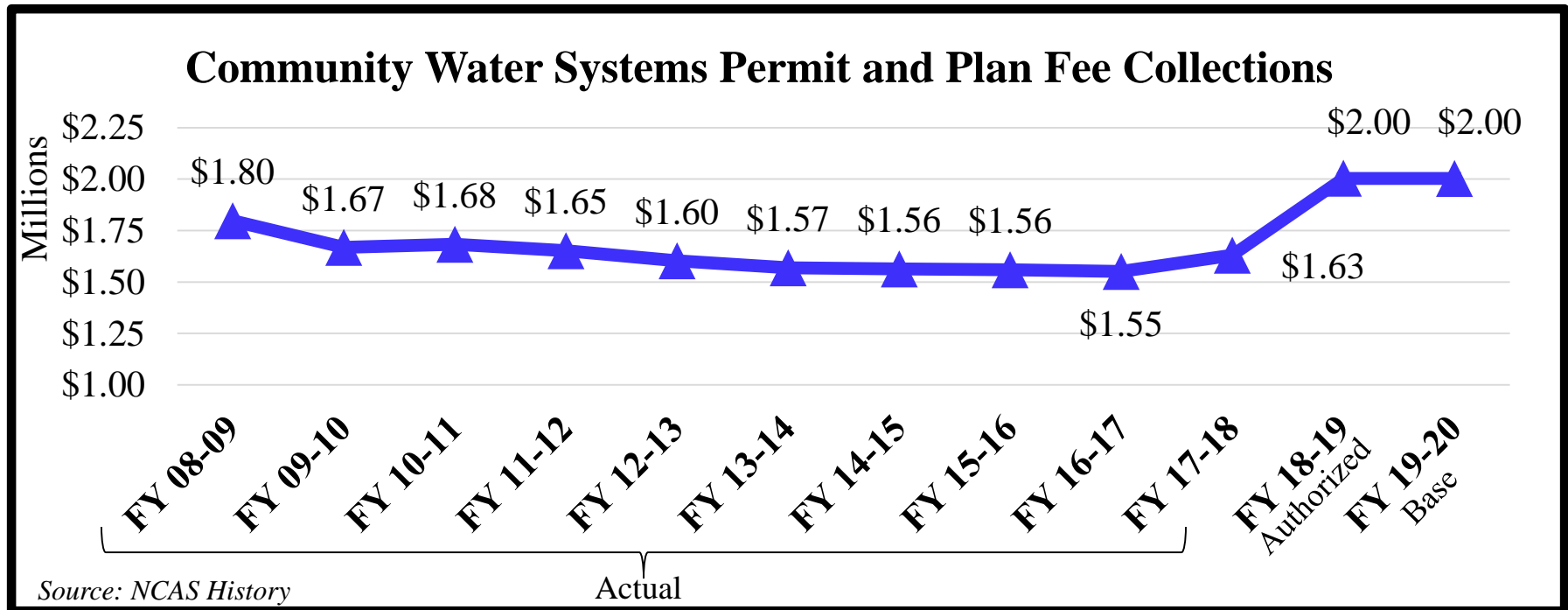

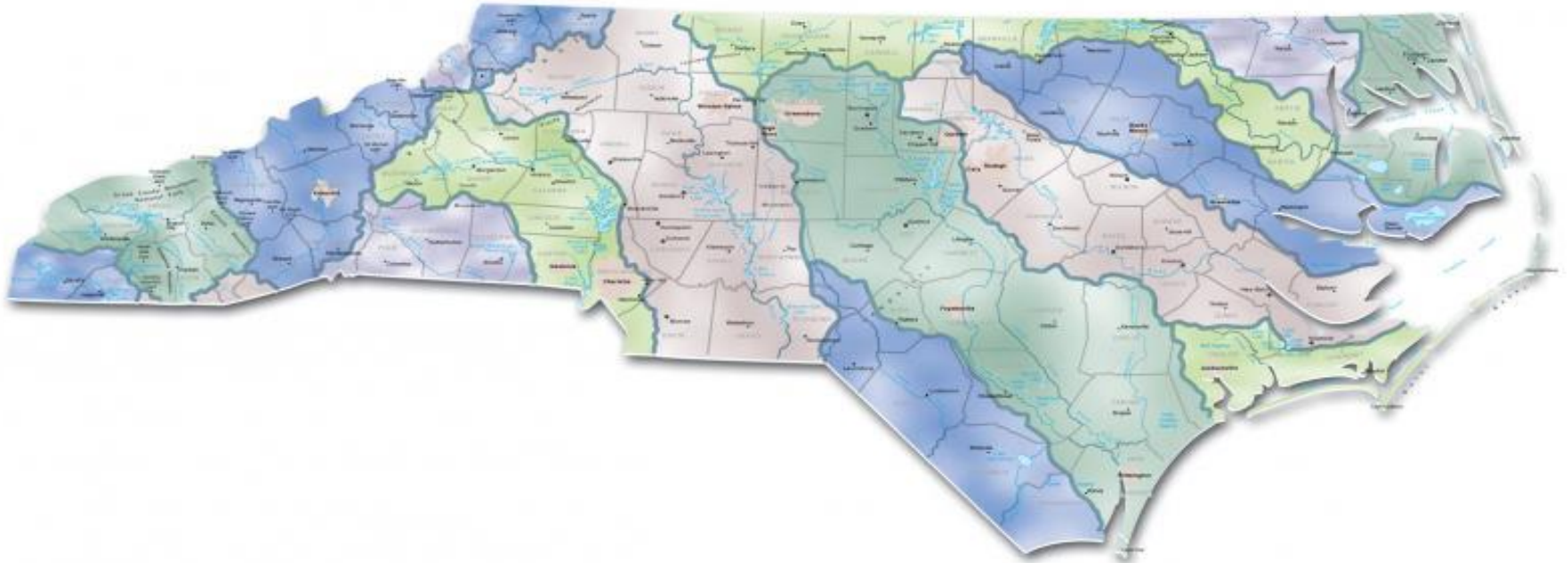
# DWR: Public Water Supply

All community and non-transient non-community water systems must have a permit to operate. (G.S. 130A-328)

Fees: \$150 to \$5,950



# DWR: Water Resource Planning



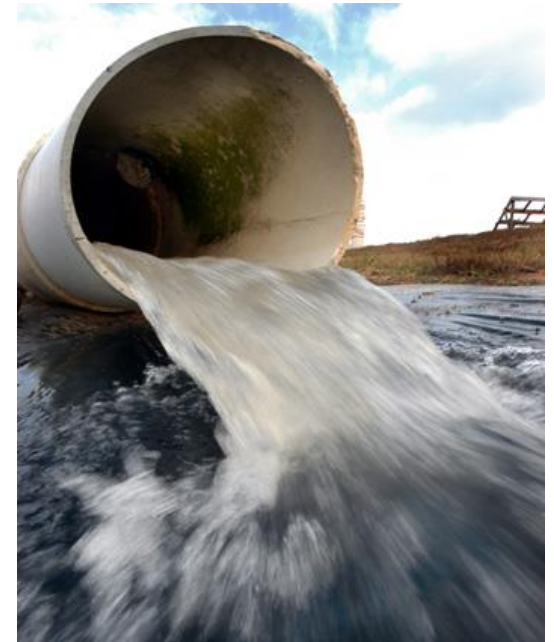
- Nonpoint source pollution control

# DWR: Water Quality Permitting

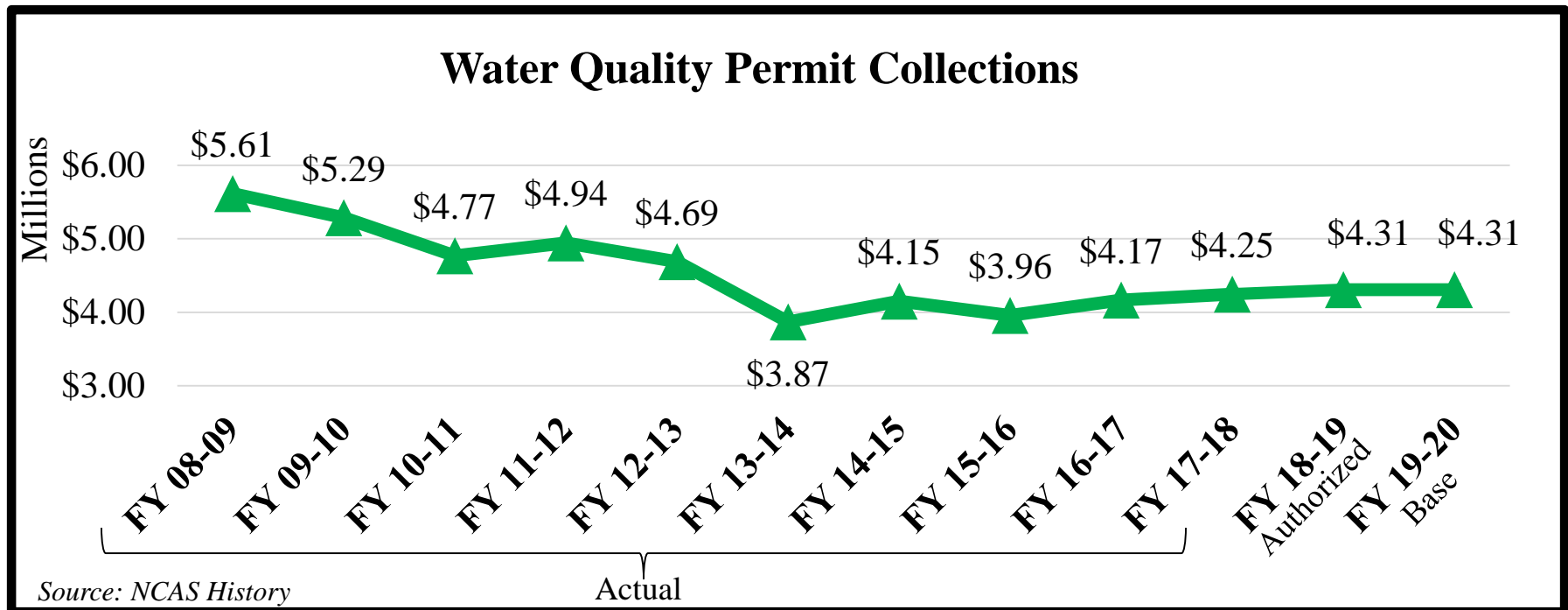
- Non-Discharge
- Complex permitting
- Compliance and expedited permitting
- Pretreatment, emergency response, and collection systems
- 401 and buffer permitting
- Transportation permitting



# DWR: Water Quality Permitting

Discharge and nondischarge wastewater and stormwater permits  
(G.S. 143-215.1; G.S. 143-215.3D; G.S. 143-215.10A *et seq.*)

Annual Fee: \$60 to \$3,440

# DWR: 2017-19 Budget Actions

## 2017 Budget

- Transferred 2.0 FTE to receipt support (\$151,924) R

## 2018 Budget

- Appropriated \$5 million NR to Resource Institute for a beach nourishment study
- Provided \$1 million R for sampling and analysis related to PFAS/GenX
- Authorized expenditure of \$1.33 m NR for time-limited positions, sampling, and analysis
- Provided \$537,000 NR for a mass spectrometer

## Disaster Funding

- S.L. 2018-136 (Florence II) provided \$2 million NR for a coastal needs assessment
- S.L. 2018-138 (Florence III) provided \$18.5 million NR for Coastal Storm Damage Mitigation Fund





# DWR: Other Funds

## Shallow Draft Navigation Channel Dredging and Aquatic Weed Fund

*(G.S. 143-215.73F)*

- State's share of costs for dredging
- Siting and acquisition of dredged disposal easements on the Intracoastal borders
- Aquatic weed control projects
- Beach and inlet project manager position



### Revenue to the Fund:

- G.S. 7A-3 – WRC Boating Account: 50% of each three-year certificate of number fee collected
- G.S. 75A-38 – WRC Certificate of Title: \$10 per \$30 certificate
- G.S. 105-449.126 – Highway Fund: 1% of the excise tax on motor fuel



# DWR: Other Funds

## Shallow Draft Navigation Channel Dredging and Aquatic Weed Fund

*(G.S. 143-215.73F)*

### 2018 Budget

- Earmarked \$15 million for Dare County dredge
- Increased aquatic weed limit from \$500,000 to \$1 million



# DWR: Other Funds

## Coastal Storm Damage Mitigation Fund

*G.S. 143-215.73M*

### 2018 Legislative Actions

- S.L. 2018-5 transferred \$5 million from Utility Account
- S.L. 2018-138 allocated \$18.5 million from the Florence Disaster Recovery Fund
