**Justification for Position (including description of duties and responsibilities):**

The number of students with disabilities increases annually and as result has become an issue for charter schools. Issues with services delivery, appropriateness of placement in the least restrictive environment (LRE), cost of special education and related services, and the lack of experienced certified teachers have resulted in a number of complaints concerning educational services. This position will focus on two areas for the state: (1) Compliance and Corrective Action monitoring and support, and (2) Monitoring and Auditing. There are currently 95 charter schools serving 3,297 students with disabilities statewide. This task is currently performed by a contractor.
