No Child Left Behind requires Title I schools in the second year of School Improvement and beyond in the sanctions to offer Supplemental Education Services (SES) to eligible students. The North Carolina consultant for SES oversees the selection process for SES vendors in the state who must be approved by the State Board of Education. This consultant also oversees the implementation and monitoring of SES in districts and charter schools. Additionally the consultant is responsible for the completion of annual reports required by the United States Department of Education related to SES in North Carolina including the evaluation of services provided by the vendors.
