

Justification for Position (including description of duties and responsibilities): The NC National Guard has an urgent requirement for a senior design/ construction project manager, with the training and ability to supervise four subordinate engineers in carrying out related work assignments. The agency has a consistent requirement to execute over \$30 million dollars in capital improvement projects every year, including large-scale renovations, new readiness centers ("armories"), and training facilities. Since major projects usually span several years, we have an ongoing workload of nearly \$74 million for projects in some stage of development.

The employee in this supervisory position will provide journey to advanced level technical engineering and contract administration skills for Army National Guard projects. The individual in this role will be the principal design/construction engineer within the project management workgroup. The employee will be responsible for design, design review, construction monitoring, inspection and management of a wide range of capital improvement projects, from routine repairs and renovations to very advanced level, complex, and large projects spanning all design and construction disciplines. The individual will provide project management skills from the time of initial designer selection, continuing through the completion of projects, and ending at the conclusion of the warranty phase.
