
Justification for Position (including description of duties and responsibilities):

The NCAWARE and ACIS Parallel project is intended to replace the current Magistrate System with a complete browser-based statewide repository of criminal processes that have not been served, including warrants and orders for arrest. The four time-limited, full-time positions are a systems analyst I (junior tester) and three applications analyst programmer III positions responsible for various programming needs (i.e., interface, java, and/or dao) and ACIS parallel.


