Name of Fee: State Lake Pier Permit Fees

Purpose of Fee: To offset the cost of managing and enforcing the State Lakes Pier Permit System.

Current Fee: Fees are based on the length of the pier. Permits for private piers average approximately \$60/year. Permits for commercial piers average approximately \$150/year.

Revenue Generated (2001-2002 FY): \$58,235

Proposed Fee: Private piers: Average \$80/year
Commercial Piers: Average \$200/year

Additional Revenue Generated: \$2,1815

Projected Total Annual Revenue: \$61,050

Rationale for Fee Increase: Help offset the budget shortfall.

Who Pays: Residents with private piers on state lakes.
