Justification for Position (including description of duties and responsibilities):

Section 143.437.46 establishes the Job Development Investment Grant program administered by the Economic Investment Committee. In order to foster job creation and investment in the economy of this state, the committee enters into negotiated agreements with businesses to provide grants in accordance with provisions in Part 143B. When a business files an application for a grant, the business must pay the committee a fee of five thousand dollars (\$5,000). The fee is due at the time the application is filed.

This position is being funded with the application fees from JDIG and was approved by the Committee. Please approve the establishment and budget for one position for involvement in the management of the business development financing programs administered by the Department of Commerce with special emphasis on the Job Development Grant program.
