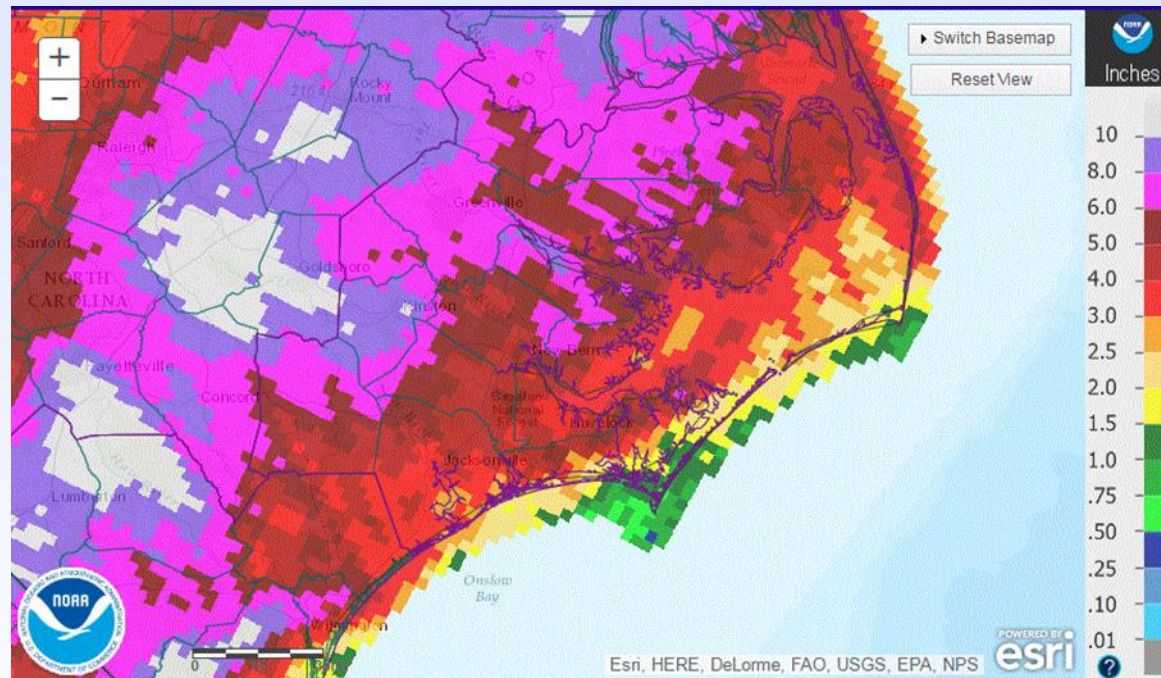


North Carolina Emergency Management Hurricane Matthew Recovery Update

Hurricane Matthew Recovery Operations



- \$99M - FEMA Individual Assistance to help 29,000 households
- \$371M - FEMA Public Assistance to repair/replace infrastructure
- \$100M - Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for buyout, elevation & mitigation reconstruction projects
- \$236.5M - CDBG-DR for housing assistance (recent allocations bring total to \$404M+)

Overview – HMGP



- Largest **Hazard Mitigation Grant Program** in NC since Hurricane Floyd
- Buyouts, Elevations, Mitigation Reconstructions – priority
- 60+ community meetings
- 18 HM-DRC operations – national best practice
- 9 sub-recipient briefings
- 2,987 survivors requested mitigation
- 800 properties across 70 grants submitted with expedited process
- Enhanced hazard mitigation state

Overview – CDBG-DR



- NC's first **Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery** program
- Partnership with Governor's Office, NC Department of Commerce and NCEM
- Currently \$237.5M with additional funds obligated
- Reimbursement, rehab, housing repair, infrastructure, buyout*

Overview – DRA 17



Disaster Recovery Act – FY17 Resilient Housing/Hazard Mitigation Funds

- 10 counties received ~\$1M/each in grants for rehab, repair, reconstruction & reimbursement. “DRA-17 Housing” – Mimic CDBG-DR
- 3 counties received ~\$1M/each for buyout, elevation & mitigation reconstruction – Mimic HMGP

Awaiting federal award letters from FEMA – expedited process	Blending contractual/ state/local resources to move residents through process	Working on pilot counties for first construction activities

2. Why are those who have been approved for teardown or buyout money still waiting to receive funds?

"Approval" = properties to be submitted to FEMA for review	"Approval"= moving households through Award process	"Approval" = defined lists per implementation field meetings
Awaiting – FEMA Award Letters	Awaiting – movement of applicants through 8-step process	Awaiting – project implementation underway

3. Hard Timeline for Funding Disbursement

HMGP	CDBG-DR	DRA 17
FEMA awards – begin late spring, staggered throughout summer/fall	Benchmarks – first reimbursement May 1; first repair – June 30.	Benchmarks - May 1 – repair underway; Oct 1 – 50-70% of repairs underway
Reimburse eligible expenses incurred by County via Cost Report process	Reimburse eligible expenses by County via Salesforce and/or Construction Managers at Risk	Reimburse eligible expenses incurred by County via Cost Report process
