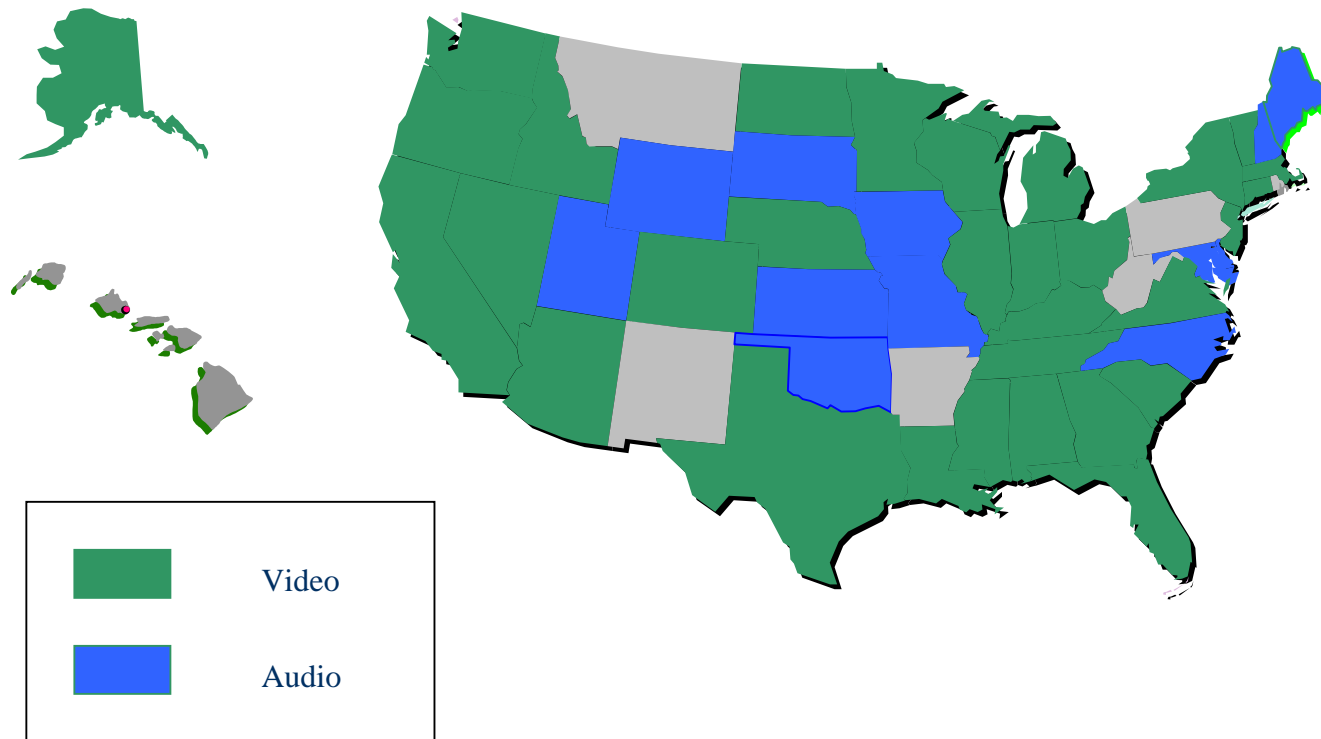

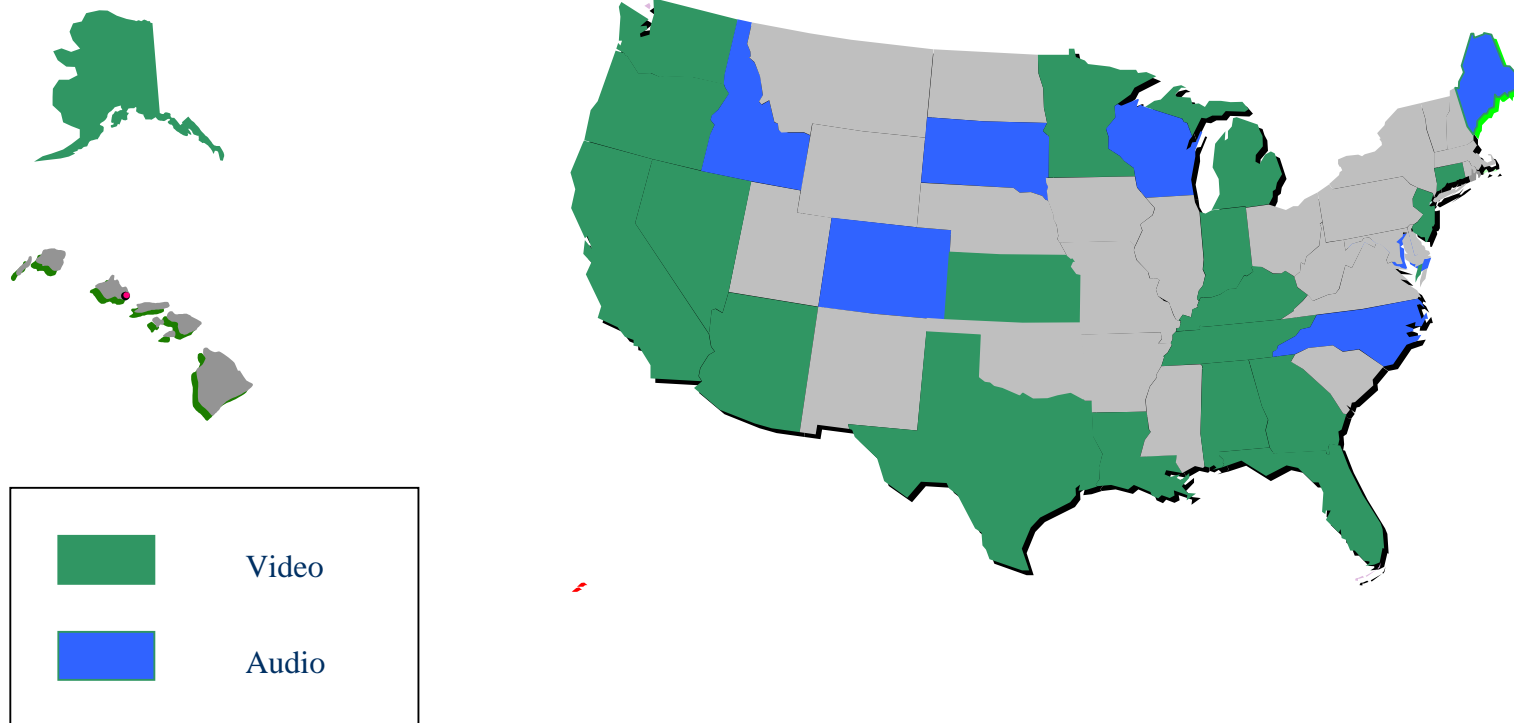

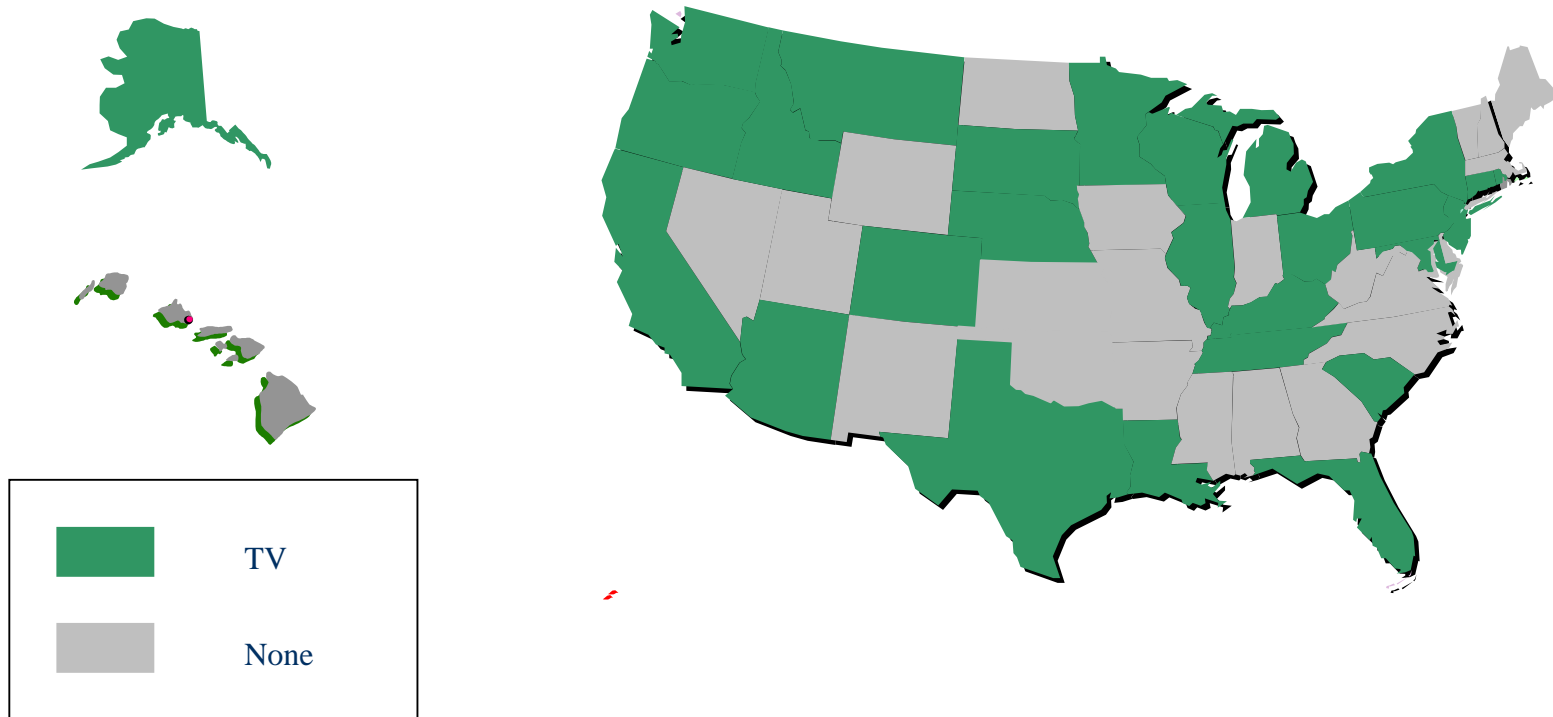
States with Webcasts of Floor Proceedings
